The exceptional quality of the CHAINEX chainmail is an additional guarantee of durability.

SAFETY

The spring strap replaces the traditional closure system with plastic (or textile) strap with buckle, press stud fastening. The spring strap does not risk unbuckling, thus guaranteeing total safety for the user.

No removable or dissociable part: no foreign bodies in production.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**Care Instructions:**

Cleaning: washing machine or scrubbing at least once a day in hot soapy water (50°C) or in a mixture of hot water (50°C) and detergent. Rinsing in hot water at a minimum temperature of 82°C. Disinfection only with approved products. They can also be cleaned in a washing machine. Do not clean chainmail protective gloves by knocking them against a hard surface.

Storage information: After cleaning, store the gloves in a cool, dry and well ventilated place.

Any glove showing signs of wear or missing chainmail must be replaced immediately by a glove in good condition. Only the manufacturer is authorized to repair defective gloves or to declare a glove beyond repair.

Tagging:

Every glove is packaged in a bag or a case on which is pasted a tag indicating the model, together with a multilingual instruction for use in 21 languages: DE, DK, GB, SP, EST, FIN, FR, GR, HON, IT, ISL, LET, LITU, NOR, NL, POL, POR, RUS, SK, SUE, TCH.
